As Lucy delves into the community, tensions begin to rise as the man’s death draws the attention of the local Gay Rights group to a hate-speech Pastor who, days earlier, had advocated

the stoning of gay people and who refuses to retract his statement. Things become further complicated with the emergence of a far-right group targeting immigrants in a local working-class estate. As their attacks escalate, Lucy and her boss, Tom Fleming, must also deal with the building power struggle between an old paramilitary commander and his deputy that threatens to further enflame an already volatile situation. Hatred and complicity abound in McGilloway’s new Lucy Black thriller. Compelling and current, *Bad Blood* is an expertly crafted and acutely observed page-turner, delivering the punch that readers of *Little Lost Girl* have grown to expect.
