- This book is mostly about Mengele's personal life and his life on the run. Thankfully, it only spends one chapter on his time at Auschwitz. The most valuable part of this book is where the authors discuss the media circus that started up around Mengele, which continued even after his death. Simon Wiesenthal is a businessman who sought to profit from the hunt for Mengele. The chapter which discusses Auschwitz includes some information from the controversial and

mysterious "Miklos Nyiszli" whose existence is doubtful. The book's one strong point is that it dispels the myths about Mengele the extremely dangerous comic-book character with superhuman powers of escape and evasion. It gives a more realistic portrayal of Mengele as a very capable and skilled doctor with some personality flaws, growing into a lonely, depressed old man. Mengele's evasion was the result of being highly alert, having dependable friends, and sheer luck. This book cannot be taken as historical literature because of the non-objective point of view it is written from, and it cannot be taken as a biography because of its GLARING OMISSIONS from a period of Mengele's life in the 1960's, so it can only be categorized as "Holocaust Literature," and it comes with

all of the usual bias and slant.
