Much to my surprise and delight, the book was a thorough account of America's foreign policy starting from Vietnam, Africa, South America, and then finally to Central Asia during what the author describes as the height of the Cold War: the American run, Muslim fought, Afghan war of the 1980s which was responsible for the recruitment and training of several current terrorists. Most notably, Bin Laden. I had never been exposed to this kind of information. I don't know if the author is being as factual as possible, but I do know that he worded his book quite well and that even with the undeniable bias of a Muslim man from Africa, I still found him very fair and analytical. Still, the way he describes how Americans like Oliver North engaged in proxy wars against the governments of many small nations, and how they funded these proxy wars with drug money... It's just so messed up that it has to be true. How the CIA wanted to 'bleed the Soviet white' by making the 1980s Afghan War 'their Vietnam.' How so many CIA trained and recruited veterans of the Afghan War are now on the FBI most wanted list. It's just....damn! That said, I think it's the perfect primer for someone just getting into non fictional books about U.S. foreign policy.
