From 1968 to Watergate, Boston's WBCN was the hub of the rock-and-roll, antiwar, psychedelic solar system. - I used to play blackjack full time in the years 1997-1999. I played solo, betting around \$10-\$50, almost exclusively single deck. At those levels, free rooms and food were a very important part of my income. Comp City was a cornerstone source of info for me. I quit playing when I was backed off from too many casinos. Also, my "game" (think shooting buffalo

or ducks), which was single deck dealt pretty far down, started drying up. I don't know how relevant Comp City is now, but it sure worked for me about 10 years ago.
