Michael gives you that switch in the 6 power steps. The "electricity" comes from you, the reader to make sure you can connect to the "machine" (tools to wealthier life). And you, the reader will setup a "wiring" to connect the "machine" and the "electricity" and adding up "detergent" -- the skills you need to polish. I am soo sorry if you could not understand my lame attempt to make you understand. But from my 5 year research, Jay Abraham will NOT jeopardize his own career and reputation by endorsing a lousy or shoddy product. I've only known Michael from ETR for few months already and those months are PROFITABLE for me.
