This book is short, but a gamut of emotions packs its pages. Not only is the reader exposed to anger and exasperation, but humor, despair, and a reintroduction to the human condition as well. The characters of George and Lennie are classic, and in my

opinion, can easily be compared with Fitzgerald's Nick Carraway and Jay Gatsby as far as memorability goes. Steinbeck, undoubtedly, has written a slew of great works including "The Grapes of Wrath" and "Cannery Row," but if ever there is a story you should read by this man, it is "Of Mice and Men." Its simplicity alone is genius and there is a lot said about power and how it is abused and lorded over the weak. Good things come in small packages...and for those high school kids out there who think it sucks...I've been there....Just give it a few years and you are likely to better understand its importance with age (and the same goes for "The Great Gatsby" while I'm on my soap box).
