Offering both the first major revision of satiric rhetoric in decades and a critical account of the modern history of satire criticism, Fredric V. Bogel maintains that the central structure of the satiric mode has been misunderstood. Devoting attention to Augustan satiric texts and other examples of satire—from writings by Ben Jonson and Lord Byron to recent performance art—Bogel finds a complicated interaction between identification and distance, intimacy and repudiation. Drawing on anthropological insights and the writings of Kenneth Burke, Bogel articulates a rigorous, richly developed theory of satire. While accepting the view that the mode is built on the tension between satirist and satiric object, he asserts that an equally crucial relationship between the two is that of intimacy and identification; satire does not merely register a difference and proceed to attack in light of that difference. Rather, it must establish or produce difference. The book provides fresh analyses of eighteenth-century texts by Jonathan Swift, John Gay, Alexander Pope, Henry Fielding, and others. Bogel believes that the obsessive play between identification and distance and the fascination with imitation, parody, and mimicry which mark eighteenth-century satire are part of a larger cultural phenomenon in the Augustan era—a questioning of the very status of the category and of categorical distinctness and opposition.

#### Bibliophile: Diverse Spines WaterBrook

This moving story about a magical bookstore explores the way war can shape a family and is perfect for book lovers everywhere, especially fans of Pages & Co., Pax, and Wolf Hollow. It's 1944 Sutton,

NY, and Poppy's family owns and runs, Rhyme and Reason, a magical bookshop that caters to people from all different places and time periods. Though her world is ravaged by World War II, customers hail from the past and the future, infusing the shop with a delightful mix of ideas and experiences. Poppy dreams of someday becoming shopkeeper like her father, though her older brother, Al, is technically next in line for the job. She knows all of the rules handed down from one generation of Bookseller to the next, especially their most important one—shopkeepers must never use the magic for themselves. But then Al's best friend is killed in the war and her brother wants to use the magic of the shop to save him. With her father in the hospital suffering from a mysterious illness, the only one standing between Al and the bookstore is Poppy. Caught between her love for her brother and loyalty to her family, she knows her brother's actions could have devastating consequences that reach far beyond the bookshop as an insidious, growing Darkness looms. This decision is bigger than Poppy ever dreamed, and the fate of the bookshops hangs in the balance.

### **REVIEW OF BLOG VIDEO BOGEL**

- This is the first book I've downloaded from the local library and listened to on a combination of CDs and iPod (depending on where I was). Prior to this I'd only read one Jennifer Crusie book, and wasn't too impressed with it. This book was much better than I expected. It explores traditional gender stereotypes about relationships and portrays two non-perfect people: Min, an overweight career-minded woman who's frightened of being hurt in relationships, but needs a date to her sister's wedding; and Cal, a relationship-scared learning disabled business owner who has been told his whole life that he's damaged goods and is scared to commit to anyone. The story also amusingly features their best friends, family members, and acquaintances, including two exes set out to destroy the main characters' blooming relationship. *Bet Me* was a terrific "read" and I was sorry to have it end. I may just read more Jennifer Crusie after this. (Although this book may have been merely a break from her usual fluff.) Whoever the audiobook narrator was, was also good, as she was able to nimbly articulate both male and female characters' voices.
