REVIEW OF MISTRESS OF THE EMPIRE TRILOGY 3 RAYMOND E FEIST

• This was one of the weaker Grisham books. It literally took me four months to finish, picking it up here and there again, reading a couple of chapters, then going on to do something else. The reason I finished it is because it was a good look into Southern culture during the desegregation era. I liked much of the social commentary, particularly that on corruption, the legal system, and segregation. But it is not suspenseful, and nothing like books such as *A Time to Kill*, which is what got me started on Grisham (even though both books take place in the same setting). Also, the ending was very disappointing - with a relatively minor character gaining the spotlight suddenly in the last forty or so pages. The killing of jurors sparked my interest, but I was expecting some sort of twisted ending - like Callie Ruffin being the mastermind of everything or something along those lines. Also, I find the writing style in this book somewhat lacking. In earlier Grisham books it was as though you could see exactly what he was describing. Here you have to labour through paragraphs and re-read them because it is unclear what kind of picture he is painting. The first-person writing style, I find, exacerbates this problem (although it worked somewhat in "The Rainmaker".)
