She travels to Venice where community groups are fighting to stop the tourism industry from pushing them out of their homes, to France where officials have made tourism their number one industry to save their cultural heritage; and on cruises speaking to waiters who earn \$60 a month--then on to Miami to interview their CEO. Becker's sharp depiction reveals travel as a product; nations as stewards. Seeing the tourism industry from the inside out, the world offers a dizzying range of travel options but very few quiet getaways"--

- This book is the 5th installment of the Earth's Childern series. The action picks up from the end of the previous book, Plains of Passage. Ayla and Jondalar have at last reached his family after trekking across what is now eastern Europe to southern France.Criticism has been made that the books are repetitious. I found that while there is definitely rehashing of actions from previous books that it was no more than is found in other series. This book, like the others in the series, could be read and enjoyed by itself or the series could be read out of sequence and still understood.Some have complained that Ayla is some sort of a supergenius who discovered 'everything'. This IS a work of fiction, there never was an 'Ayla', a single person who had all of these experiences or made all of these discoveries but her experiences are all possible and probably did happen to others. All of the advances Ayla made, domesticating animals, sewing together wounds, needles etc were made by somebody during this time period. Actually they were probably made many times by many different people throughout the world over many centuries.The author brings to life a time period that we have only scant circumstantial evidence about. Her world is probably a much nicer place than what really existed but it is a thorough depiction of a possible society of this time.This is an enjoyable read and I am waiting for the next book in the series.
