REVIEW OF EU SOU MALALA EDICAO JUVENIL DEWESTBAAK

- I found the book to be light-hearted, fun and relatively fast-moving. True, it was predictable, but that didn't detract from Capella's take on the triad of Bruno, Laura and Tomasso. In fact, it was nice to see how Cappella put his spin on the Cyrano story. The descriptions of the food and the locale enhanced the story and added to the atmosphere, though at times were a "trifle overdone" (pun intended). The only thing that kept me from giving this a 5 was the author's descriptions of the sex scenes which were at times too graphic -- too male, perhaps, like reading Playboy/Penthouse letters -- for my taste. In all, though, the book was entertaining and a fun way to occupy a few summer afternoons.

- This is a very sensual book, bringing to life the smells, sights and taste of Italy, while being held together and given flow by a romantic love story that is both touching and unusual. Capella writes as lovingly about food as he does about his the characters and the result is sumptuous, warm and very, very readable.
