Firstly, the problems of the law before the reform and the reasons for the reform will be discussed. Secondly, the law introduced by the reform will be described; and thirdly, the solution offered by the reform and its interaction with the rules on passing of property and passing of risk will be critically analysed. The author will argue that while the reform seemingly successfully responds to all problems of the old law, after scrutiny it is clear that the reform suffers from inconsistency and immanent injustice and fails to provide the intended protection to the buyer. Until September 1995 where a buyer bought a specified quantity forming part of an identified bulk, i.e. 250 tons of wheat from a named ship carrying a cargo of 500 tons, he could not acquire property in the goods until the goods were ascertained. This was result of a mandatory rule in s. 16 which provided that "where there is a contract for the sale of unascertained goods no property in the goods is transferred to the buyer unless and until the goods are ascertained." The most serious consequence of the mandatory rule in s. 16 was that the buyer did not acquire property in the goods even though he had paid for it and received a document purporting to be a document of title. If the seller became insolvent before the

goods were ascertained, both the paid price and the goods in the bulk passed to the office-holder in insolvency for the benefit of secured cre

knowledge and application of Biblical Scripture is refreshingly interwoven throughout the story, and serves to expose and convict the hypocrisy of human merchandising. Amongst the plethora of characters is my personal favorite, Augustine St. Claire, who ultimately succumbs to the crushing realization that even a "good" master is plagued with the inherent wickedness of the horrific business. Of course, the novel's title character, Uncle Tom, is a gem; enlightening the reader to true spiritual conversion and self-sacrifice, as he followed the example of His Lord and ours, Jesus Christ. Though this "fictional" work stands brilliantly on its own, it is imperative to mention that one year later, in 1853, Stowe released a non-fiction explanation, through her publisher, entitled "A Key to Uncle Tom's Cabin - Presenting the Original Facts and Documents upon Which the Story Is Founded, Together with Corroborative Statements Verifying the Truth of the Work." It seems to me an absolute necessity for posterity to own this companion piece, lest we ever forget the veracity & relevance of the original.
