REVIEW OF THE ROYAL BALLET 75 YEARS

- Well, this particular title has certainly brought about some interest in a number of people. And I thought no one read the classics anymore...After writing my review I began reading the novel again, for at least the fourth time. There is one interesting passage early on dealing with the sanctity of the individual human spirit, and of the author's pledge to defend the individual's right to think freely, to the death if necessary. I found it odd, at first, that this passage was included at the particular point in the story, since the concept of choice and free will was not brought up until quite later. Given the fact that the novel was published at the height of the McCarthy era, however, it does make some sense. John Steinbeck, as it was taught to me, was considered only a minor master in the field of literature, certainly not the equal of Hemingway or Faulkner. I've always disagreed,

and I have wondered to where this disparaging attitude among many academics can be traced. Not all of his novels were masterpieces. "In Dubious Battle," while a great story, often reads like propaganda. Steinbeck fares better with stories such as "Grapes of Wrath," "East of Eden," and "The Winter of Our Discontent," which present to the reader a much more balanced and ultimately more authentic take on human nature. He does, however, show some interesting weaknesses in his portrayal of female characters. Despite his flaws, Steinbeck was a compelling author, and certainly a voice of honesty. As was once stated, he "had no mind to be an unoffending comforter and entertainer..." And that from the Swedish Academy after presenting the author with the Nobel Prize in 1962. Certainly Steinbeck was no lightweight escape novelist.
