REVIEW OF BEING EMILY

- I'm building my first computer and had already made some hardware choices based on internet reviews and tutorials. This book gives a very comprehensive, though somewhat dated, step

by step procedure for building a PC, that starts with the selection of all the components. Very helpful to beginners. Although the book covers all the basics, be prepared to do some serious research on the net to supplement the data found in the book and needed in the areas of current hard drives and there setup, with particular regard to size vs cluster allocations. The book is not really good in addressing the new Fat 32 partitioning formats, or in dealing with Windows 98 issues in general. If your going to build a system with a moderate size hard drive, and install Windows 95 as your OS, this book will get you there in great shape. At the end of each construction segment you test your system and if it doesn't respond properly, the book is very good about outlining possible causes and cures. This feature saved me on a couple of occasions. I would like to see the author put out a supplement based on current hardware, setup(Fat32)and OS software now available. I'd buy it in flash!
