at letting its readers get into the mind of the main character in his novel *The Stranger*. *The Stranger* takes us through the daily life of Meursault, who is a man that lacks ambition for life and cares very little about the actions that he takes in his life. The novel starts out with Meursault receiving notice of his mother's death. His reaction to this is very out of the ordinary, because he doesn't have a reaction. He thinks that his mother's death will not change anything in his life. That scene, and the next scene in the novel lead me to believe that this man does not have any ambition and lacks self-confidence. The next scene involves Meursault shooting an Arab on the beach in

which he killed for no apparent reason. Killing the Arab makes his life take a turn for the worst. He ends up going to jail and goes on trial to serve the death penalty. His lack of ambition and will to live makes this novel interesting as it takes you on a journey for the rest of his life.
