She is concerned neither with the image of blacks nor with the image of whites, only with revealing the complexity, the full truth. This truth condemns the racism upon which apartheid is built. In her nine novels and eight volumes of short stories, Gordimer digs deeper and deeper until she has thematic layers. These include betrayal-political, sexual, every form and power, the way human beings use power in their relationships. Her accounts in these interviews of how she works and of which writers she admires will fascinate readers, scholars, teachers, and students alike. Co-editors Nancy Topping Bazin retired from the faculty of the English and women's studies departments at Old Dominion University, and Marilyn Dallman Seymour retired from the staff of the Government Publications Department of the Old Dominion University Library.

The modern voice was not a distraction to me. I'm giving this a 4-star rating because I would have liked the characters to have more depth. A few of them just fell a little flat. More importantly, I wanted to be moved emotionally. There were brief moments of emotion but there could have been more. I think this would have happened with more character development. I wanted to see into their very souls. Where the author really succeeded was in showing how bad some of these kings were. It is amazing how little it takes to start down the wrong path. Good King dies, unrighteous king reigns and tragedy befalls the people. Let me tell you, this King Ahaz was not one of the good ones!!! Additionally, we see the fall of an individual who makes concessions on his faith with the belief that he will then bring everyone back. Little does he know where that one choice will take him! The journey to evil doesn't usually start with one dark, dastardly deed. Usually, as illustrated so adeptly by the author, it

begins with small steps leading down a path toward that deed. I look forward to seeing what the author has to offer in the next book of the series.
