- I was excited to finally receive this book since it just came out and I wanted some material specifically focused on the BSCN, but now I'm disappointed. It was clearly rushed from the publisher as it contains typographical errors, wrong answers to review questions, and just plain incorrect information. If you have the book, check out section 3.3.1 where the author mentions that without using 0 and 255 as addresses, there are 253 available hosts. Hellloooo. My advice is to get ahold of the Cisco Press ACRC book (from CCNP v1.0) and use that in conjunction with this if you must. Hopefully, the publisher will come out with an errata soon (it will be lengthy) so people don't learn wrong information. The bottom line is this: if you have other materials, even if they are older, use those until better books come out. Follow Cisco's exam outline and use public documents and specifications. Follows newsgroups (alt.certification.cisco, comp.dcom.sys.cisco).My one good comment about this book is that the FAQs at the end of chapters are intelligently crafted with some good thoughts and information.
