What should I do? We ask the question when we pray. We ask it when we run out of answers to our problems. We ask it when we face big decisions. Young Vietnamese women seeking to discern a religious vocation often

confuse their own unconscious motivations and desires with what they perceive as the "will of God" for their lives.
